6th Grade Statewide Honor Chorus 2024 Information

The purpose of 6th Grade Statewide Honor Chorus is to provide selected students with the opportunity to work with other students of equal caliber under the direction of highly qualified master conductors and musicians. Selection to Sixth Grade Statewide Honor Chorus recognizes excellence in musical knowledge, technique and interpretation. Each school is allowed to bring four 6th grade students with unchanged voices. Students will be chosen based on their participation in chorus class and audition if needed.

The 6th Grade Statewide Honor Chorus Event will take place on February 9-10, 2024 at UGA Tifton Campus Conference Center in Tifton, Georgia. Students must be able to attend the entire event in order to participate. You will need to stay in Tifton with your child. You are responsible for securing your own hotel room. Please check your calendar carefully before applying as we cannot substitute students if you have to drop out.

Parents will be responsible for chaperoning their own child during the entire event including hotel stay and meal times. During rehearsals, parents are free to leave the Conference Center, but please make sure you are available by cell phone in case there is a problem.

The cost to attend 6th Grade Statewide Honor chorus is \$60. This includes the registration fee, music and rehearsal tracks. Music is yours to keep after the event. Additional expenses to the students who are selected to attend will include hotel, travel and meal expenses in Tifton. It is also your responsibility to provide appropriate performance attire. We will wear our blue music t-shirt the first day for rehearsals. Students may wear school clothes to rehearsals the second day.

Performance Attire:

GIRLS will wear 1) a floor-length black dress with sleeves or jacket 2) a floor-length black skirt and black blouse with sleeves or jacket, OR 3) black floor-length pants and black blouse with sleeves or jacket. Blouses will hang below the waist of a skirt by 3 inches. Also, girls are to wear black shoes that completely encompass the foot. Flip flops or sandals of any kind and clogs present a safety issue when maneuvering steps or risers and are not acceptable attire.

BOYS will wear a white, long-sleeved dress or tuxedo shirt, black bowtie, black pants, black socks and black shoes that completely encompass the foot. Flip flops or sandals of any kind present a safety issue when maneuvering steps or risers and are not acceptable attire.
