Overview

Chorus utilizes a Standards-Based Curriculum which focuses on the following nine standards.

- Performing alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music
- Reading and notating music
- Improvising melodies, variations, and accompaniments
- Composing and arranging music
- Listening to, analyzing and describing music
- Evaluating music and music performances
- Understanding relationships between music and other disciplines
- Understanding music in relation to history and culture

Uniforms

We have 2 uniforms for chorus. Students need BOTH.

Formal Uniform: Blue polo with black SLACKS and completely black shoes. This is worn for most major performances. The polo is worn tucked in. Leggings and jeans are not to be worn with the formal uniform.

Informal Uniform: Blue music t-shirt – worn for field trips, outdoor concerts and other informal events. Director will specify if blue jeans should be worn as part of a concert uniform or if shorts or other bottoms may be worn in a field trip setting.

All students in 8th Grade Chorus, Band and Orchestra are invited to travel with us to Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida.

The dates for this trip are March 7-11, 2024. The cost for students will be in the ballpark of \$1000-1100. This will include all but one meal (fast food on the way home), 4 nights lodging (4 students per room), bus transportation, Disney Imagination Campus recording workshop and 3 days park admissions. 8th Grade Only GMEA In-Service Conference Performance

As most of you know, the 8th Grade Chorus has been invited to perform for the Georgia Music Educators' Association In-Service Conference in Athens, GA. This is the primary professional development opportunity for music educators in the state of Georgia. As part of the conference, choirs from around the state are invited by audition to perform. This year only 2 middle school choirs were chosen to be part of the concert series for the convention. Northwestern opens the concert series on January 25, 2024, at 7pm. This concert is not open to the public, only official chaperones and conference attendees will be admitted. We will have a send-off concert on January 11, 2024, at Alpharetta Presbyterian Church at 7pm for parents and the community.

We are looking for sponsors for this trip to help defray the cost of this amazing experience. The cost for transportation, me als, program printing and paying our musicians totals a little over 10K. Eighth grade is an expensive year and I feel strongly that students should be able to attend this trip at no additional cost to their families.
